League rules, Playing Format & Nominations

### i. Revert Division 1 to 4 players.

In an effort to define the best league make up, a Committee led working group of Division 1 Team Captains will decide Division 1 format and specific rules for the coming season. To be done by June 31<sup>st</sup> [Ian Ball to action].

#### ii. Move match scoring to Par-15

Par-15 is not supported. A move to Par-11 should be considered/encouraged in future seasons . 2019-20 scoring will continue as Appendix 3 Option 2 of the WSF 2019 singles rules, HiHo-9. [No Action]

- iii. Restrict club sharing of players across teams in the same division to team position.
  - Not possible automatically with the current Leaguemaster software. 3 Options are available for player selection and we will continue with our current setup of Option C [No Action].
    - a. All Club Nominations
    - b. Team Nominations only
    - c. Team Nominations and teams below.
- iv. Allow Club nominations for teams in the same division to be competitive, not on merit.

  Current strict merit order nomination throughout the club is preferred. [motion defeated]
- v. Reduce Home Bias from anti-social home fixture limit of 50% at weekends.

  Meeting agreed the league should not dictate home night. [motion defeated]
- vi. Increase Entry submission deadline to 4 days

  Meeting agreed 72 hours is an ample period for results submission [Motion Defeated]

#### vii. Reduction of walkover penalty to -2 points per player not fielded

Rules state 4 players required to fulfil a fixture. A 4 point penalty is applied to that team (unless the bottom team of a club) for that missing player. Reducing the penalty to -2 [Motion Passed]

viii. Points Penalty for late payment of entry fee

Meeting agreed entry fee payment should be in advance of the league start or team to be removed from the league. **[motion defeated]** 

### Competitions

- i. York Open 2020 Dunnington will host and organise event in February. Fixtures to allow a week away from Half Term for the event to run. Leaguemaster tournament package offered through Yorkshire League is a positive tool and should be reused.
- ii. **Riley Cup 2020** All teams to be entered automatically, event to run past the end of the league season.
- iii. **York Vets and Vintage** 2018 event not held due to lack of entries. 2019 event to be discussed with the longterm organiser Nick Clifford. Provisional date to be in November.
- iv. **York Classic** Professional Squash event hosted at Dunnington Squash Club, an event worth supporting and promoting to the Y&DSL Membership.

#### Team Entries 2019-20

- i. Deadline is **July 31**st. Fee is held at **£25 per team**, payable before the season
- ii. Nominations to be submitted onto Leaguemaster before September 1<sup>st</sup>.
- iii. Heslington and Selby are regrettably lost to the league.
- iv. Scarborough and St.Peter's school are welcomed to the league as are Selby (playing as Selby), out of the facilities at Garforth squash club. Secretary to contact Bridlington to request a team entry.
